



NEW AT THE CONRAN SHOP: THE 'EVERYDAY' RANGE BY BRITISH CERAMICIST EMMA LACEY

17 March 2011: New at The Conran shop this month is the 'Everyday' range by British ceramicist, Emma Lacey who from her studio in North London, makes ergonomic hand thrown stoneware using traditional techniques. A welcome antidote to standardized mass production, Emma Lacey's ceramics are all made in the UK and have a comforting, ergonomic feel that offer an opportunity to engage with products that you will want to get to know and fall in love with. Grey stoneware is mixed with a lighter clay and sometimes porcelain to give a unique and subtle surface finish. Prices range from £25 - £85.

In Emma Lacey's work, most surface decoration is defined by the texture of the materials used or the function of the design. Simplicity in surface and form means her ceramics can happily exist among the objects you already own.
